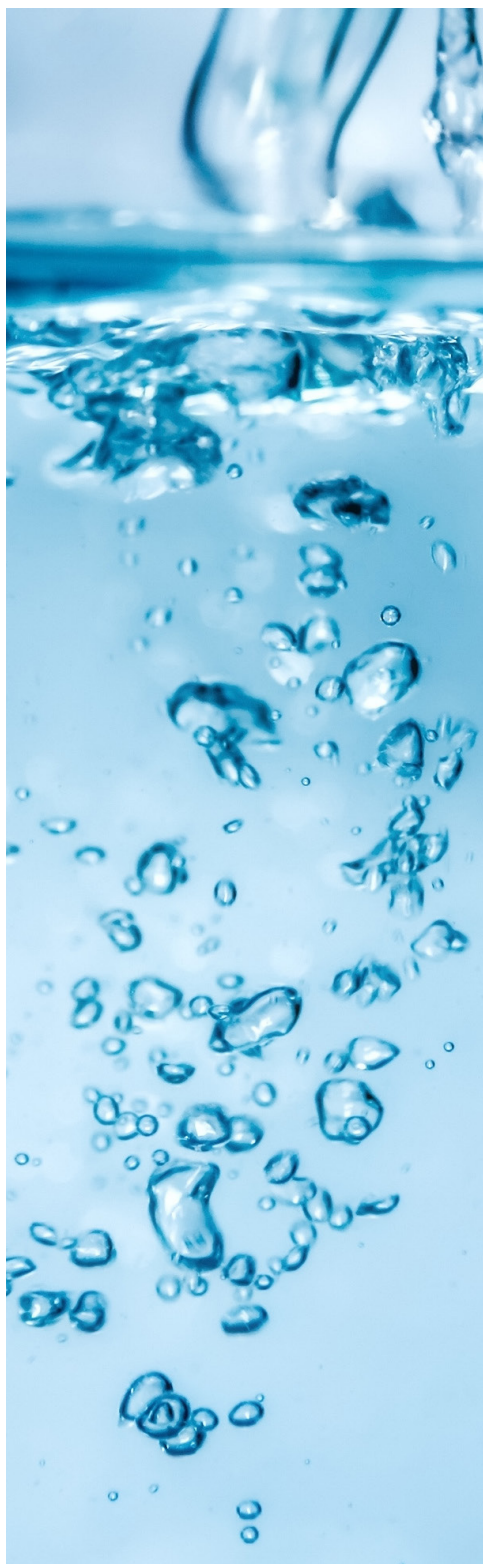


Eastern Arizona Native American Water Master's Association (NAWMA)
