Tribal wastewater operators, managers, directors, and board members are encouraged to attend this two-day workshop focused on the unique needs of tribal wastewater systems. General information on wastewater utilities will be shared, including valuable material on: wastewater collections; preliminary, primary, and secondary treatment; and basic wastewater laboratory. An emphasis on lagoon treatment, maintenance, repair, and safety will develop the tribal wastewater operator's in-depth understanding of the most common method of wastewater treatment in this region. Attendees

will participate in insight-sharing conversations about the challenges of operating a utility beneath the umbrella of the Tribal Council's authority. Join RCAC's trainers for this two-day, twelve contact-hour workshop, and take your expertise in tribal wastewater systems to the next level!
