Cross Connection Control and Backflow Prevention

The purpose of this webinar is to provide water system operators with the knowledge, skills and resources necessary to protect connections between the water system from any source of pollution or contamination due to backsiphonage or backpressure to ensure that water quality standards and public health are maintained. This session will include an introduction to Cross Connection Control Programs, an overview of the concepts of backpressure and backsiphonage, cross connection control devices and prevention, testing of devices, and conducting cross connection inspections.
