About the workshop

The Nevada Open Meeting Law, first passed in 1960, declared the legislative intent that actions taken by public bodies be taken openly and that their deliberations be conducted openly. On June 13, 2019, the Nevada State Legislature passed AB70, revising Chapter 241 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS), commonly referred to as the Nevada Open Meeting Law. This online course is a review of the core concepts codified in the law and a summary of recent changes to the NRS that are important for members of public bodies to know.

The 2019 Nevada legislative session brought several changes, some of those impact your legal responsibilities involving open meetings. In this online course you will learn the changes to the law, as well as a brief refresher on the law as a whole.
