

Sewer Lagoon O&M, Regulations, System Upgrades and Energy Solution Training

This training will focus on sewage lagoons systems operations and maintenance, issues to look out for and the regulations driving many systems to consider upgrading to mechanical treatment processes. Keeping in mind that upgrading to more complex treatment processes comes with larger utility demands, guest speakers will discuss programs for systems to consider when incorporating renewable energy into their infrastructure upgrades.

RCAC has invited diverse speakers to compliment this training including Barbara Bennet of CDPHE, who will speak on regulations that impact Lagoons, Paul Young will speak on DOLA Pilot Program funding for alternative technologies, like the one underway in Platteville. A representative from Colorado Energy will introduce the Energy Performance Contracting Program to finance infrastructure upgrades, GRID Alternative, a nonprofit renewable energy developer focused on solar projects and workforce development for rural Colorado.
